### Pastor's Corner

I would like to name April as the official sharing month, at least the beginning of our sharing. Let me explain further. This year in place of flower pots welcoming us into church (the new entrance), we will have vegetables in those pots. My hope is that these pots will produce an overabundance of tomatoes (yellow ones), or peppers (again yellow) and baby butternut squash (that's the literal seed name!). My hope is that you can pick these as they are ready and enjoy some fresh vegetables at home- even if you grow your own stuff. So why is April the beginning of sharing? Some of us will begin our own vegetables inside our homes. Often we grow too many or have too many of what you don't want. For instance, it's too easy for me to start and grow 4 jalapeno plants. I however only need or want 1 plant (3 last year was too many). So I plan to share the other 3 plants. I'll probably start too many eggplant as well. I can put the other ones on our extra Bounty table and share with some that might also just want 1 plant. Does this leave out the non-gardeners in the sharing? Absolutely not! You produce too much of something (i.e. cookies, flowers, etc.) What could you bring to share at the table? It will be placed between the two doors and covered with a plastic table cloth. This will be there all summer until we get some harvest that you can also share. Too many cucumbers? Bring 'em. Too many zucchini? Bring those too. I think you get the idea. Maybe someone will take the extra eggplant and make a yummy dish and share that with a neighbor. Sharing seems to be an easy way to love on our neighbor. Let's be creative and find ways to share with each other, those in need and our wider community.
