## Pastor's Corner

Recently I finished the book "Alienated America" by Timothy Carney. He wrote, "Modern disenfranchisement was really the disappearance and erosion of the layers of society where an individual and a family can make a difference" (pg. 214). This sentence saddens me. I understand it to mean that folks no longer feel that they make a difference and their voice isn't heard. One can blame that on big government, over-regulation and/or a whole bunch of things. Usually the last area we place blame is ourselves. I'm a pretty regular voter- but that can't be said for our society. We don't often vote. We don't directly participate in our local government. We like to complain on Facebook or other social media without actually doing something about that which we don't like.

As a congregationally based church, we face the same issues. We have 2 meetings per year where members are asked their opinions and to contribute to the future planning of the church. Our last meeting was well attended, but it is still only about $10 \%$ of our total membership. Do our nonvoting members feel disenfranchised?

But I am an optimist! I don't like the quoted sentence because I don't feel disenfranchised and I still feel that I and "we" can make a difference in our world. The church must wrestle with this idea that many feel unheard and also that many simply don't wish to participate. How we continue to engage our community and how we ourselves participate in our on-going church ministries set the tone for our future. As we approach our bicentennial (2023), we must figure out a way to include more voices in our leadership, planning and execution of church ministries. You have a voice both in our world and in this church. May that voice ever be used to speak of God's glory and participate fully in God's earthly kingdom.
