Welcome to March!

There are many exciting things happening at EUC for Lent this year. It all kicks off on Ash Wednesday (March 6) at 7:00 PM. That service has been attending by about 30 in the past couple of years. That seems like a decent number for our church; however I'm not sure why it's not a priority for more of you. Ash Wednesday is a somber service that reminds us of our death. It's not glamorous but it does prepare us for a season of preparation. We prepare for new life in Christ that comes from the Easter celebration. The ashes on the forehead are a symbol of our death and our proclivity to sin. We then enter into a time of personal reflection to appreciate how much Jesus impacts our daily life.

There will be several opportunities to deepen your faith this Lent season following Ash Wednesday. A Psalm Bible Study will be led by Rev. Ray. That begins on March 7 at 7:00 and will go for 6 weeks. Chair Yoga will begin on March 8th at 11:00. "Holy Yoga" a class offered by Joann Wadsworth, will begin March 13 at 6:30 (Donations for the classes are welcomed). The yoga courses will be offered through Lent and longer if enough interest is present. Later in Lent we will worship together on Maundy Thursday. The sermon series in Lent this year will be "Giving up" and you will be given a list of activities that you can either give up for a day or a challenge that you can accomplish. There are 40 of these activities/challenges and also 40 days of things to pray for. This list will be distributed on March 3rd. Please take the seasonal opportunities to deepen your personal faith.


