#### Pastor's Corner

Happy October everyone!

Have you ever entered a restaurant and been shown to your seat? What do you expect to happen next? At a nice eating establishment with courteous servers you will be greeted and asked what you wish to drink with your meal. Restaurants have goals of greeting their patrons within 2 minutes of being seated. This is in addition to the front person greeting you. Now what happens when this fails? If you're like me you sit patiently for a few minutes looking at the menu. It's not a big deal until you've decided what you want to eat and still have no drink in front of you and the server still hasn't come over to say hello or even, "I'll be with you in just a minute." If you are like me, you begin to question the quality of the restaurant.

In our Hebrew Scriptures hospitality was a big deal. These attempts at welcoming and assisting one another were key in survival. In the New Testament, Paul picks up on this when he instructs the church at Rome: "Let love be genuine; hate what is evil, hold fast to what is good; love one another with mutual affection; outdo one another in showing honor. Do not lag in zeal, be ardent in spirit, serve the Lord. Rejoice in hope, be patient in suffering, persevere in prayer. Contribute to the needs of the saints; extend hospitality to strangers." (Romans 12: 9-13).

How do we extend hospitality to "strangers"? We have 2 sets of unlocked doors on a Sunday for worship. If a new guest were to enter the front doors how long might that person sit before being greeted? Patrons of restaurants will leave if not greeted promptly enough. Jesus instructs his disciples, "As you enter the house, greet it. If the house is worthy, let your peace come upon it; but if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. If anyone will not welcome you or listen to your words, shake off the dust from your feet as your leave that house or town." (Matthew 10: 12-14). Is Jesus being overly harsh? Are we underwhelming with our hospitality?
