Happy April everyone,

I love this time of year. Easter teaches us again that death is not the final answer. Jesus rose from that grave and is alive. We express that life through our daily actions of love. We will celebrate Easter together on April 17th. The following Sunday will be another celebration of life of a different kind: Arbor Sunday. This year you will have 2 choices of plants to take home to plant in your yard. Lindera Benzoin and Cercis Canadensis. The first one is more commonly called Spicebush and is not an actual tree. It does grow to be a rather large bush and attracts butterflies. The second is a repeat from a few years ago and is commonly known as Redbud. Last year as we drove down to Missouri for the start of our Sabbatical the route was lined with Redbud and it was amazing! This small tree gets purple flowers in early spring and has heart shaped leaves. Somehow the flowers just make you feel good. There will be about 15 spicebush shrubs and 20 redbud trees. Please consider where you might plant one of these beautiful plants as we honor Arbor Sunday together. (If there are extras when all have had a chance to take a plant, you are welcome to have more than one- but please allow each family to take one first).
