As I shared at your congregational meeting it is time to begin moving forward with the search process for your next called minister. We will begin that process by choosing folks for a "Transition Team."

"The purpose of the Transition Team is to help the congregation during the "in-between time of interim. settled pastors," bv assisting the Interim Transitional Pastor and working with them to help the congregation recognize and accept the transition time as a journey where new experiments happen, when changes in the "way we've always done..." take place, when new pastoral leadership calls for flexibility and adjustment."

#### ARE YOU READY?!!

The answer is "YES" because we believe and have faith that God is equipping you and the Holy Spirit is leading you. You will frequently hear me say (as you already have) take a deep breath and hear these two words ~ Process & Journey! This is a time to claim the best of who you have been and are ~ A  $200^{\text{th}}$ Year **Celebration!** And be bold, courageous, creative, and open to the work of the Holy Spirit within The Edinburg United Church Body of Christ as you live into your future.

If you have served on a Search Committee in the past, you'll remember the first task is to have conversations about who you are, what your dreams are, and where is God calling you. Once you have gathered all this information you are finally ready to begin putting your profile together. And you are probably very tired!

The Transition Team is a small group of members (3-5 folks) to do that work. Once *they* have gathered the information it is given to the Search Committee to begin their work of developing your church profile. The two groups are different in personality and the tasks they do.

At the congregational meeting I handed out a card identifying key gifts and skills for a member of this committee:

- Good listener
- Keeps confidences
- Good facilitator of conversations ~ "Tell me more!"
- Open minded
- ✤ Respected member
- **\*** Faithfulness to God's Calling

Please give the names of your 3 suggested members to myself or Lisa by February 5<sup>th</sup>. We will take your suggestions to the council and select the folks who we will invite to work directly with me on the Transition Team. Please see me with any questions you have regarding this important work in the life of your church and the Search Process.

#### **Unofficial Council Minutes**

December 8, 2022

PRESENT: Pastor Susan, Lisa Morehead, Audie Morehead, Cyndi Oblisk, Matt Finney, Sabrina Finney, Roger Mansfield, Barb Rohn

Meeting was called to order at 6:35 PM and opened with Prayer.

ELECTRICAL ISSUES: Mike Oak who has provided services in the past, has retired. Matt has been contacting Dennis Pennington for the Church electrical needs.

CARPET CLEANING: Pricing for Sanctuary is \$350, Pews \$300, Entrance and Hall \$170, totaling \$820. It was consensus to use Stanley Steamer.

SALVATION ARMY TREE: Jeneen was unable to attend tonight but sent message that there are 7 tags still left on tree. After some discussion, Roger motioned that the Church donate \$700 to assure that the children on those tags receive their Christmas gifts. Sabrina seconded the Motion. Motion passed.

200<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY: The original Founding Date for Church was May 18, 1823 so we will have our main Celebration on May 21, 2023. Several suggestions were made for services and food and it was decided to revisit this at our January Meeting. Jeneen will have meeting December 13 from10 until 12 to continue working on memorabilia.

PIE MONEY: It was suggested that this year's money be used for the 200<sup>th</sup> Celebration. Sabrina motioned that pie money be used for this. Cyndi seconded the Motion. Motion passed.

TOWEL DISPENSERS: Cyndi announced that they are here and will be installed after current supply of towels have been used.

Matt shared that the Church is in need of Snow Plowing Services; suggestions are welcome.

Matt and Sabrina shared that they have a senior in the Girl Boy Scout Troop that wants to put up a Flag Pole for the Church as her Eagle Scout Project.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 PM and closed with Prayer
