Is God a charity?

When we consider our financial giving to the church, do we see this as charitable giving? On average in the United States each person donates 2.1% of their income to "charity." In Edinburg, our average income level is \$50,000 at 2.1% giving that would amount to a gift of \$20 weekly (50,000 x .021 then divide by 52). But giving to God is *faith* giving- not charity. In Genesis 28, "Jacob rose early in the morning and he took the stone that he had put under his head and set it up for a pillar and poured oil on the top of it. He called that place Bethel, but the name of the city was Luz at the first. Then Jacob made a vow saying, "If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat and clothing to wear, so that I come again to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God, and this stone, which I have set up for a pillar, shall be God's house; and of all that you give me I will surely give one-tenth to you." Notice the if-then statement. Also notice that Jacob seeks something from God. It wasn't charity- it was security, protection, sustenance - one could even call it reward. Jacob set up faith giving. Something we give to God with recognition that God blesses the gift. There are plenty of examples from the Bible about faith giving. Jesus talks a ton about money too. Have you examined your faith giving amount lately? I feel it fairly unlikely that reading this quick letter will convict you to examine years of charity giving vs faith giving. Please note this is NOT a plea for the church budget- this is a plea for your life. God blesses those who trust and are obedient and give. God wants our whole heart and we show that we trust and are obedient with our money much more than any other aspect of our lives. The book that helped convict me is called "You of Little Faith" by Ryan Thomas. I'll loan you my copy if you are willing to dare yourself to give by faith and trust that God provides more than enough.
