The Meeting was called to order by Lisa at 6:30 PM and opened with prayer by Pastor Susan.

Minutes read and approved as read.

SIGNAGE: Tina Finney is now taking care of church sign at the direction of Lisa.

200th CELEBRATION: Lisa reported that this is progressing smoothly with no current updates.

LITERACY BREAKFAST: The Dr. Seuss Event for this was quite successful with approximately 80 children and their families attending. Suggested changes for next year were discussed.

OUTDOOR CLEANUP: This will be scheduled for sometime the end of April.

COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS: Council members will be giving updates each month for their assigned areas beginning at April Council Meeting.
